

RESOLUTION – 001

June 05 of 2017

By means of which it summoned and regulation of the **1st PANAMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP OF NATIONS OF SKATEBOARDING 2017 Male and Female**, qualifying to the Pan-American games of Lima 2019, to be realized in the city of Bogotá, Colombia, from the 10 to 13 of August, 2017.

The president of the **Pan-American Skating Confederation (CCP)** and the Pan-American commission of skateboarding, in use of its legal, bylaw attributions and;

CONSIDERING

That the 2017 Pan American Calendar foresees the accomplishment of the **1st PANAMERICAN NATIONAL SKATEBOARDING CHAMPIONSHIP 2017 Men and women**, qualifying to the Pan American games of Lima 2019, to be realized in the city of Bogotá, Colombia, from August 10 to 13, 2017.

- That is the duty of the confederation, to promote the massive practice of the skating in America in all its modalities.
- That it is desire and commitment of the executive committee of the confederation to carry out continental events.
- That is the duty of the confederation; regulate all events of the official calendar in all the modalities of skating.

RESOLVE

ARTICLE 1° ANNOUNCEMENT

Convene and regulate the 1st **PANAMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP OF NATIONS OF SKATEBOARDING 2017 Male and Female**, qualifying to the Pan-American games of Lima 2019, to be realized in the city of Bogotá, Colombia, from the 10 to 13 of August, 2017.

ARTICLE 2° REGULATION

The regulations that apply to the skateboarding events of the Panamerican Skating Confederation are those approved by the international Roller Sport Federation (FIRS) Technical Skateboarding Committee (CTSB), In force on the date of the events.

ARTICLE 3° PARTICIPANTS

All practicing athletes registered with the endorsement of their respective national federations may participate.

PARAGRAPH 1. An athlete can register and participate in a higher age category if he considers that his technical level is appropriate for it, but once enrolled he will not be able to descend of category in the same event or later.

PARAGRAPH 2. The minimum age to participate is 14 years old as of January 1, 2017.

PARAGRAPH 3. All the ages will be taken based on the age the athlete has on January, 2017

PARAGRAPH 4. The quotes by category will be limited with priority to the order of inscription and a maximum of 5 quotes is granted by weapon and category for each country.

ARTICLE 4°. DIRECT INSCRIPTIONS

It will be received only through the official website www.cppatinaje.org; In response will receive a confirmation message.

The payment must be made in cash on Thursday, August 10 from 1pm to 6pm at the information meeting; the deadlines for receiving registration are as follows:

FOR NO REASON REGISTRATION WILL BE ACCEPTED OUTSIDE THE DATES BEFORE INDICATED AND THE PARTICIPATION OF THOSE WHO ARE NOT ENROLLED IS NOT ALLOWED.

PARAGRAPH 1. The registration fees will be made exclusively in US dollars.

PARAGRAPH 2. Event qualifying to the Pan-American games of Lima 2019 in skateboarding for the modalities of Street and Park, Will receive quote the nations that participate in the Pan-American events of 2017 and 2019 with any number of athletes independently of the modality and the result.

ARTICLE 6° PREVIOUS ACTIVITIES

The skatepark will be able to practice the registered to the event for recognition and training on Thursday, August 10 from 7 to 10 PM, at the same time and place will be handing out handles, receiving payments, child permits and verification of Identity documents.

At 6:00pm at place close to the track there will be an informative meeting for delegates or coaches of clubs, teams or delegates by cities, as well as individual athletes may participate in the individual interest.

PARAGRAPH 1. The preparatory meeting prior to the event will be purely informative, it will not be possible to make changes of regulations, categories, programming, among others.

PARAGRAPH 2. The athletes must be present to the Pan-American Board of skateboarding, THE ORIGINAL IDENTITY DOCUMENT FOR EACH REGISTERED ATHLETE, as an indispensable requirement to take part in the event and validate its age and nationality. Photocopies of the documents will not be accepted.

ARTICLE 7. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

The PANAMERICAN SKATING CONFEDERATION AND THE EVENT ORGANIZATION don't assume any responsibility for accidents that may occur during the event, therefore, each athlete, delegate, coach and judge must have their current accident insurance, EPS, health prepaid, etc. In the same way, the foreign athlete participating in the event must have his current insurance to cover any risk of a sports accident.

PARAGRAPH 1. All participating athletes must present themselves to the test with their complete implementation; the use of helmet, knee pads and elbow pads is suggested.

ARTICLE 8. EVENT AUTHORITIES

- The highest technical authority, are the delegates of the Pan-American confederation of skateboarding.
- The highest disciplinary authority will be the Disciplinary commission of the event, made up of CCP delegate, a representative of the Colombian Federation of skating and the chief judge of the event.

PARAGRAPH 1. Only the CCP, Will be able modify or cancel a particular test that does not conform to weather conditions, space, risks, warranty faults of unforeseen delays in the normal programming.

ARTICLE 9. SYSTEM OF JUDGING AND QUALIFICATION ACCORDING TO REGULATION FIRS.

PARAGRAPH 1. The criteria of the judges are:

- Amount of tricks
- Difficulty of tricks
- Skater Style
- Variety of tricks

- Numbers of mistakes
- Number of lines and space used

PARAGRAPH 2. Composition of the jury (5 international judges) and the qualification system:

Each judge will give between 0 – 100 points per Round and skaters there will be two rounds, the best result is the one that will be taken into account:

- 85 – 100 Points very good performance
- 65 – 84 Points above the average level
- 45 – 64 Mid-level points
- 25 – 44 Points below average level
- 0 – 24 Points poor level

The lowest and highest score of each skater will be eliminated; the remaining 3 scores will be added. The SKATER with the highest qualification will be the winner and the others will be ranked in order of scores and these positions will give the general classification.

ARTICLE 10. AWARD

An award in medals, implements and cash will be awarded at the end of each event according to the following table.

ARTICLE 11. DISQUALIFICATION

The Athletes who are identified by judges or the organization consuming drugs, alcoholic beverages or smoking in the competition scenario or its surroundings will be disqualified from the event and will not be able to participate in any test of it.

ARTICLE 12. APPEALS

The jury's judgments or the qualifications are unappealable against them does not apply any procedure or superior instances.

ARTICLE 13. CASES NOT PREDICTED

The cases not foreseen in this Resolution will be solved by the delegates of the CPP - Skateboarding in accordance with the FIRS International Regulations.


ARTICLE 14.


